Subject: - Section 18 of the Free and Compulsory Education of Children Act, 2009 For this purpose, a certificate of accreditation for the school under sub-rule (4) of Rule 11 of the Free and Compulsory Education of Children Rules, 2011.

Mr. Mann / Mati ji,

In the application letter received from you and in the correspondence / reference with the school after that I for Doon International School Gurdaspur Block Gurdaspur-1 from class I to class VIII from 01-04-2020 to 31-03-2023 to issue temporary recognition for three years till 03-2023. This approval will be considered valid only after fulfillment of the following conditions:

1. Accreditation approval period cannot be extended and in no case is there any commitment for accreditation beyond class VIII.
2. In strict compliance with the Right to Free and Compulsory Education of School Children Act 2009 (Annexure 1) and the Compulsory and Free Education of Children Rules 2011 (Annexure 2).
3. The school will enroll in first class and 25 percent of the class in it. Provide free and compulsory education till the end of elementary education to the weaker sections and non-profitable students who will be in their neighborhood. This rule will also apply to pre-primary categories. For the students referred to
4. Paragraph 3, the school shall comply with subsection 2 of section 12 of the Act and provide a separate bank account for the same.
5. The school will not collect any forced fees from any parent or guardian for any action.
6. The school will not refuse admission to anyone:
  - (a) to any child who does not have proof of birth or
  - (b) if such a child is shown or extended (for admission) if admission is granted.
  - (c) on the basis of religion, caste, creed, place of birth or any of these factors.





7. School will ensure
- (a) No student will be required to pass any board examination before completing elementary education.
  - (b) No student will be subjected to physical or mental punishment.
  - (c) No student will be required to pass any board examination before completing elementary education.
  - (d) As per Rule 21, each student will be awarded a certificate on completion of elementary education.
  - (e) Students with disabilities, disability or special needs will be admitted under the law.
  - (f) The teacher appointed in accordance with sub-section (1) of Saxon 23 fulfills his / her educational qualifications. If pre-employed, they will complete their required minimum educational qualifications within 5 years of coming into service from the date of enactment of the Act.  
Teachers shall perform their duties under the rules laid down in Section 24 and Sub-section (1) of the Education Act.
  - (g) Teachers will not involve themselves in any kind of private tuition.
8. The school will follow the schedule and curriculum distribution regulated by the competent governing body / authority.
9. The school will enroll children in the proportions prescribed in Section 19 of the Act.
10. The school will comply with the criteria as per Section 19 of the Right to Education Act. The facilities which have been identified as per the previous inspection, if any, are as under: - As per the report. Area of the school as per report) Total area computed (as per report. Area of playground as per report) Number of classrooms (as per report) Related Materials Availability of Sports Equipment / Library Materials
11. No non-accredited category will be taught on or off the premises of the same school in the name of the school.
12. The school will be used only for the development of skills.
13. The school may be run by a registered society under the Act (Act No. 21 of 1860) or for some time run by a public body.
14. Schools are not run to the benefit of any individual class or individual alliance.
15. The school accounts should be audited by a certified accountant / CA: and a table of accounts should be prepared as per the rules. Interest will be sent.
16. Accredited identification of your school According to the above. (Please take note of this and indicate this in future when dealing with this identification number)

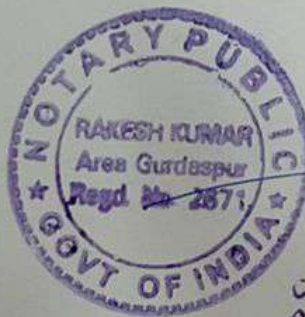




17. The school will forward all such reports and information to the District Education Department from time to time and to the State Government or the local administrator as an officer or director. Will be bound to provide information directed by them in time, which will eliminate the shortcomings of school which are necessary for it to be rectified. The registration of the institution has been renewed.
